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Articles of Incorporation

We, the undersigned, the President and the Secretary, respectively, of the San Luis Obispo County Employees' Association, and existing non-profit corporation, do hereby subscribe our names hereto, having been first directed by the members of said Association for the purpose of amending the Articles of Incorporation to read as follows and under the General Non-Profit Corporation Law of the State of California, and we hereby certify:

Article I

The name of the corporation is: San Luis Obispo County Employees' Association, Incorporated.

Article II

The purposes of which this corporation is formed are:

A. To encourage friendship, harmony, cooperation and efficiency among public employees of San Luis Obispo County; to improve public service and to aid in the development and improvement of government; to promote understanding and harmonious relationships between the administrations of political subdivisions and their respective employees; to promote consistently with public interest, the general welfare of public employees, the payment of adequate wages and the existence of satisfactory working conditions for public employees; to urge the observance of high standards of conduct among public employees in San Luis Obispo County in the performance of their official duties, to assist them to render the best service possible to the people of San Luis Obispo County, to establish and maintain an employees' association within the meaning of Chapter 10, Section 3500 et. seq., California Government Code, and to maintain and operate said employees' association for the purposes as set out in said Government Code sections.

B. To possess and exercise all the powers conferred by law upon non-profit corporations and to have all other powers and to do all other acts necessary or incidental to the administration of the affairs and for carrying

out the purposes of this corporation, including without limitation, and or all of the following acts or things:

(1) To buy, lease, rent or otherwise acquire, hold or use, own, enjoy, sell, exchange, lease as lessor, mortgage, deed in trust, pledge, encumber, transfer upon trust or otherwise dispose of any and all kinds of property, whether real or personal, and including shares of stock, bonds or securities of other corporations and wherever situated;

(2) To receive property by devise or bequest, subject to the laws regulating the transfer of property by testamentary disposition, to act as trustee under any trust, and to receive, hold, administer and expend funds and property subject to any such trust;

(3) To borrow money and to contract debt; to issue bonds, notes and other evidence of indebtedness, to secure the same by any or all of the property of this corporation, or to issue the same unsecured;

(4) To apply for and obtain grants of public monies to promote the purposes of this corporation and to take all necessary and proper actions to qualify for said grants;

(5) To enter into, make, perform and carry out partnerships, joint ventures and contracts of every kind for every lawful purpose and without limitation as to the amount with any person, firm, association, municipality, county, state, government or municipal or governmental subdivision;

(6) Notwithstanding any of the above statements of the purposes and powers, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the primary purpose of this corporation;

(7) The enumeration of the foregoing purposes and powers of the corporation is not intended, and should not be construed to limit or restrict in any manner the powers now or hereafter conferred upon the corporation by the laws of the State of California.

Article III

This corporation is organized pursuant to the General Non-Profit Corporation Law of the State of California.

Article IV

The County, in the State of California, where the principal office for transaction of the business of the corporation is located, is the County of San Luis Obispo.

Article V

The names and addresses of the persons who are to act in the capacity of Officers and Directors until the selection of their successors occur are:

Article VI

This corporation does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit to the members thereof and is organized for non-profit purposes.

Article VII

A. Articles of Incorporation as stated may be adopted, amended or repealed by the membership of the San Luis Obispo County Employees' Association, Incorporated, and shall not conflict with laws of the State of California Governing Non-Profit Organizations. Method for repealing or amending the Articles of Incorporation shall be set forth in the By-Laws of the San Luis Obispo County Employees' Association, Incorporated.

B. By-Laws of this corporation may be adopted, amended, and repealed by the Directors as provided by law. Said By-Laws and amendments thereto shall not conflict with the provisions of these Articles of Incorporation. The method for repealing or amending the By-Laws of the San Luis Obispo County Employee's Association, Incorporated shall be set forth in the By-Laws.

C. The qualifications of members, the different classes of membership, if any, the property, voting and other rights and privileges of membership or classes of members, and the liability of such members for dues, assessments, contributions and the method of collection thereof shall be set forth in the By-Laws of the San Luis Obispo County Employees' Association, Incorporated.

D. The number of Officers and Directors of the Corporation may be fixed and changed by the Corporation's By-Laws.
